§ 31-5-51. Performance and payment bonds; persons entitled to sue on payment bond; proof of general liability insurance required before entering into certain contracts with state or local governments.

Title 31. Public Business, Bonds and Obligations > Chapter 5. Public Works Contracts > Chapter 5. Bonds Securing Public Construction Contracts

(1) Any person entering into a formal contract with the state or any county, city or political subdivision thereof, or other public authority for the construction, alteration, or repair of any public building or public work, before entering into such contract, shall furnish to such public body, except as provided in subsection (5) of this section, bonds with good and sufficient surety as follows: (a) A performance bond payable to, in favor of or for the protection of such public body, as owner, for the work to be done in an amount not less than the amount of the contract, ...

... bonds; persons entitled to sue on payment bond; proof of general liability insurance required before entering into certain contracts with state or local governments. .... such contract, shall furnish to the public body proof of general liability insurance coverage in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) ...
